LET'S SPLIT UP

» The Indians wrap up the split-squad portion of their 2018 Cactus League schedule this weekend, dividing the team on both Saturday and Sunday...yesterday, half of the Tribe faced Chicago-NL in Mesa, while the other half took a road trip to Las Vegas, Nevada to play the Cubs in Big League Weekend at Cashman Field...Cleveland remains in Las Vegas this afternoon for another matchup against the Cubs, while the Arizona half of the Tribe will head to Peoria to take on the Seattle Mariners

» The Tribe has gone 4-2 in split-squad contests this spring, winning both games on Feb. 28 (vs. SEA, at LAA) and breaking even on Mar. 11 (win at KC, loss vs. MIL)...overall in 18 previous split-squad dates since returning to Arizona in 2009, the Indians have posted a record of 18-16-2 (.531).

TODAY'S MATCHUP AT CHICAGO-NL

» Cleveland and Chicago-NL face off for the final time in 2018 Cactus League play, in an afternoon contest in Las Vegas, Nevada...the two teams split yesterday's interstate doubleheader, with the Tribe winning in Mesa, 5-1, and the Cubs taking the game in Las Vegas, 11-4...on March 7, the Cubs won the first tilt 11-6.

» Cleveland has a 16-7-1 (.696) record in 24 Cactus League tilts against Chicago-NL, dating back to the Tribe's return to the desert in 2009...the Indians won two of the three games against the Cubs in last year's spring matchup, and tied in the other game.

» The two clubs are scheduled to meet this year in Interleague play for the first time since 2015, when they split a pair of two-game sets 2-2...this year, the Tribe will host the North Siders at Progressive Field April 24 & 25, and the series will conclude at Wrigley Field on May 22 & 23...Cleveland is 9-9 (.500) in regular season play against Chicago-NL.

TODAY'S MATCHUP AT SEATTLE

» The Arizona half of the Tribe will take on the Seattle Mariners in Peoria in the second and final of two 2018 spring matchups between the clubs...Cleveland won the first game, 4-2, in another split-squad game on February 28.

» In 20 all-time Cactus League matchups, Cleveland owns an 12-6-2 (.667) record against Seattle...the clubs split their two spring games in 2017.

» The Indians and Mariners will square off in Seattle to begin their 2018 campaigns with a three-game set at Safeco Field from March 29-April 1...the Mariners will visit Progressive Field for a four-game set April 26-29...the Tribe went 4-2 against Seattle in 2017, and has a 223-177 (.558) overall record in regular-season play.

ON THE MOUND TODAY: STEPHEN FIFE AND MIKE CLEVINGER

» RHP STEPHEN FIFE makes his second start and fourth appearance of Spring Training today against Chicago-NL...tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in his first spring outing at Cincinnati on February 25...started on March 1 at Los Angeles-NL (3.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1BB)...also threw a scoreless inning on March 12 vs. Texas...overall has no record and a 1.50 ERA (1ER/6.0IP) this spring.

» Fife has faced the Cubs in Spring Training once, earning the win on March 21, 2013 while with the Dodgers (6.0IP, 7H, 3R, 2ER, 1HR, 3K)...also made one regular season start against the Cubs on August 4, 2013, striking out five in 5.1 innings...Fife pitched in the Cubs organization in 2016, going 0-2 with a 4.58 ERA in 10 starts at the Triple-A and Rookie levels.

» Tribe RHP MIKE CLEVINGER is due to make his fifth Cactus League start this afternoon against the Seattle Mariners, after being scratched from his last start due to illness...started the Tribe's desert opener on February 23, tossing a scoreless inning...faced the Mariners on Feb. 28, allowing one run on two hits over 2.0 innings of work...struck out a spring-high six batters in 3.0 innings on March 5 at Los Angeles-NL...overall has a spring record of 0-0 with a 4.00 ERA (4ER/9.0IP) across his four starts.

» Clevinger has one prior spring appearance against Seattle, tossing 2.0 innings of relief on March 8, 2016, striking out three batters...he has never faced the Mariners in the regular season.

MEDIA INFORMATION: The Press Room at the Goodyear Complex opens at 7:30AM on game days...The Indians clubhouse is open to members of the media with proper credentials for roughly 50 minutes prior to morning workouts and again from 11:15AM-Noon on game days...The clubhouse may close at certain times for team meetings, etc...For all games played at Goodyear Ballpark, a shuttle is available from the Indians Player Development Complex to Goodyear Ballpark beginning at NOON and will run for approximately 30 minutes after the final out...Goodyear Ballpark media dining room is located behind the press box and serves lunch for \$7 on game days...While the game is in progress, upon request, players that have been removed from the game can be made available near the Indians clubhouse located in the RF corner after exiting the game...Indians Manager Terry Francona will be available every morning around 9:10AM (subject to change) in the Press Room.

» INF JOSÉ RAMÍREZ (right ankle contusion) exited yesterday's game for precautionary reasons, after getting hit with a thrown ball while stealing a base.

» OF LONNIE CHISENHALL (right calf tightness) was scratched yesterday...he is in the starting lineup today in Peoria, playing right field and batting third.

» RHP MIKE CLEVINGER was scratched from Thursday's start due to illness, and is scheduled to start today against the Seattle Mariners in Peoria.

» C YAN GOMES (right shoulder soreness) did not make the trip to Las Vegas...he took four at-bats as a designated hitter in Friday's Triple-A game, and is in the Tribe lineup today against Seattle in Peoria, catching and batting second.

» RHP JULIAN MERRYWEATHER (right elbow UCL sprain) underwent "Tommy John" surgery March 9 in an operation performed by Dr. Keith Meister...the 26-year-old right-hander did not appear in Cactus League action this spring and will miss the duration of the 2018 season.

» OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY (Oct. 18 right ankle surgery) continues to progress toward full baseball activity, and began working on defensive lateral movements last week...began baserunning drills on Sunday and started outfield work on Monday...he took two at-bats as a designated hitter in one of the Tribe's Minor League games on Wednesday, and hit his first spring home run yesterday.

» OF BRANDON GUYER (Oct. 11 extensor tendon surgery) re-aggravated his left wrist injury; received an MRI on Feb. 22 and began his return to baseball activities Feb. 27...he has begun hitting off a tee and is progressing towards unrestricted batting practice...he went 3-for-3 in a Minor League game yesterday.

» RHP DANNY SALAZAR (right shoulder inflammation) remains a few weeks behind in his throwing program; he is expected to begin throwing off a mound soon...he is participating in weighted ball work and throwing from 130 feet, as he progresses towards throwing off a mound.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP AT CHICAGO-NL (Mesa)

» Dominant pitching and a grand slam catapulted the Tribe to a 5-1 win over the Chicago Cubs yesterday at Sloan Park in Mesa.

» RHP TREVOR BAUER pitched into the sixth inning en route to his second spring victory (5.0IP+, 6H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 1HR)...Bauer also struck out seven batters over his 5.0-plus innings, giving him a team and MLB-leading 25 punchouts overall this spring.

» LHP ANDREW MILLER (1.2IP, 3K), RHP CODY ALLEN (1.1IP, 1BB, 3K) and RHP DAN OTERO (1.0IP) combined for 4.0 hitless innings in relief.

» C ROBERTO PÉREZ provided the big blow on offense for the Tribe, hitting a grand slam in the fourth...Pérez went 2-for-3 in the game, and now has three homers this spring...the slam marked the Indians' MLB-leading fifth of Spring Training...OF TYLER NAQUIN doubled in Cleveland's other run in the seventh.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP AT CHICAGO-NL (Las Vegas)

» The other half of the Indian fell to the Cubs, 11-4, in Las Vegas last night.

» LHP RYAN MERRITT took the loss, allowing eight runs on 11 hits over 3.0 innings, with five strikeouts...RHP CAMERON HILL (0.2IP) and RHP EVAN MARSHALL (1.0IP, 2H, 1K) made scoreless appearances in relief.

» INF MIKE NAPOLI hit his first longball of spring, a two-run shot that got the Tribe on the board in the seventh...OF BRANDON BARNES also homered, a two-run bases-clearer in the ninth...INF JASON KIPNIS went 2-for-3, increasing his spring batting average to .486 (18-37).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#52 - RHP MIKE CLEVINGER: Tossed a scoreless inning against the Reds in the Tribe's first spring game...in 2017 set career bests in wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21) in three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...finished 4th on the team with 12 wins...struck out a career-high 9 batters on June 27 vs. Texas; matched it on August 12 and 26...made four starts during the Tribe's 22-game win streak, going 4-0 with a 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP)...won his last five starts, a new career-long win streak...also made 7 starts for Triple-A Columbus, going 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA.
