TWINS NOTES:

- THE TWINS** extended their postseason losing streak to 17 games, breaking a tie with the 1975-79 Chicago Blackhawks of the NHL for the longest playoff loss streak among the four major North American professional sports.
- THE TWINS** are now 4-12 in postseason games decided in the last at-bat, as well as 1-1 in playoff games played in the month of September.
- THE TWINS**, per approval from Minnesota Governor Tim Walz and Major League Baseball Commissioner Rob Manfred, welcomed Twins front office employees, along with family members of both Twins and Astros players and staff, as guests to today's game at Target Field...the crowd was less than 250 people, seated in a socially-distanced fashion throughout the Delta SKY360° Club (Twins front office staff) and suite level (players' families).
- KENTA MAEDA** made his 25th career postseason appearance and fourth start, working a playoff career-best 5.0 innings, with no runs and just two hits allowed...became just the sixth starting pitcher in Twins/Senators history to toss at least 5.0 shutout innings in a playoff start, joining Johan Santana (7.0 IP, Oct. 5, 2004; ALDS Game 1 at NYY), Jack Morris (10.0 IP, Oct. 27, 1991; WS Game 7 vs. ATL), Les Straker (6.0 IP, Oct. 20, 1987; WS Game 3 at STL), Earl Whitehill (9.0 IP, Oct. 5, 1933; WS Game 3 vs. NYG) and Walter Johnson (9.0 IP, Oct. 11, 1925; WS Game 4 vs. PIT)...among that group, Maeda is the only one to allow two or fewer hits in his scoreless start...also became just the second Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to allow two or fewer hits across at least 5.0 scoreless innings in a playoff start, joining New York-AL's Masahiro Tanaka on October 12, 2019 in Game 1 of the ALCS at Houston...this afternoon, Maeda fanned five batters, one shy of his postseason career high, and walked three batters, doing so for the second time in a playoff start and first since October 15, 2016 at Chicago-NL in Game 1 of the NLCS.
- NELSON CRUZ** doubled in the Twins' first run in the third inning, driving in Max Kepler...at age 40.090, became the first Twins/Senators hitter age 40-plus with a postseason extra-base hit, as well as the first with an RBI...also became the first quadragenarian in the majors with a playoff extra-base hit since the Astros' Carlos Beltrán also doubled on October 17, 2017 in Game 4 of the ALCS at New York...marked Cruz's 36th career postseason RBI (in 45 games), third most among active players and trailing only Albert Pujols (54 in 77 games) and Miguel Cabrera (38 in 55 games)...Cruz's 36 career postseason RBI are also fourth most all-time among Dominican-born hitters, behind Manny Ramirez (78), David Ortiz (61) and Pujols.
- BYRON BUXTON** recorded his first career postseason hit, singling to rightfield in the first inning...today marked his second career playoff game.
- SERGIO ROMO** appeared in his 30th career postseason game, tying David Robertson and Wade Davis for fifth most postseason appearances among active players...issued a bases-loaded walk to Jose Altuve in the top of the ninth inning that put the Astros ahead 2-1; per *Baseball Reference*, became the first pitcher in baseball history to walk in the go-ahead run in the ninth inning.

•**RYAN JEFFERS** started behind the plate and batted eighth in this afternoon's contest...he became the second rookie catcher to start the Twins' first game of a postseason...he joined George Mitterwald, who also started at catcher and batted eighth on October 4, 1969 at Baltimore in Game 1 of the American League Championship Series.

ASTROS NOTES:

- THE ASTROS** are now 2-0 all-time in postseason games with a "Wild Card" moniker, having previously defeated the New York Yankees, 3-0 in The Bronx, in the winner-take-all 2015 AL Wild Card Game.
- THE ASTROS** scored all four of their runs this afternoon with two outs...the club's 68 two-out RBI in 45 postseason games since 2017 are tops in baseball in that span, passing Los Angeles-NL (65 RBI in 36 games) this afternoon.
- FRAMBER VALDEZ** earned the win in his postseason debut, working 5.0 scoreless innings in relief of Zack Greinke...became the first pitcher with at least 5.0 scoreless relief innings in a postseason since San Francisco's Madison Bumgarner closed out the Giants' 2014 World Series title with 5.0 empty frames in Game 7 on October 29, 2014.
- DUSTY BAKER**, the first skipper in MLB history to take five different teams to the postseason, also subsequently became the first to pick up a managerial win with five clubs...he piloted the San Francisco Giants to an 11-13 mark over three playoff trips, the Chicago Cubs to a 6-6 mark in their lone October trip in his tenure, the Cincinnati Reds to a 2-7 record in three appearances and the Washington Nationals to a 4-6 ledger in back-to-back appearances...with today's win in his Astros postseason managerial debut, he is now 24-32 all-time.
- ZACK GREINKE** made his 17th career postseason start, fifth most among active pitchers, trailing only Justin Verlander (30), Clayton Kershaw (25), Jon Lester (22) and Max Scherzer (18)...at just 4.0 innings, today's start marked the third-shortest outing of his postseason career, after a pair of 3.2-inning starts on October 4, 2017 in the NL Wild Card vs. Colorado (3.2 IP, 4 ER) and October 7, 2019 in Game 3 of the ALDS at Tampa Bay (3.2 IP, 6 ER)...also was the fourth time in his playoff career that he allowed one or fewer runs, alongside his starts on October 25, 2019 in Game 3 of the WS at Washington (4.2 IP, 1 ER), October 17, 2019 in Game 4 of the ALCS at New York (4.1 IP, 1 ER) and October 4, 2014 in Game 2 of the NLDS vs. St. Louis (7.0 IP, 0 ER).
- GEORGE SPRINGER** tied the game on an RBI single in the top of the seventh inning...marked his 29th career postseason RBI, which is third most in Houston history, behind Carlos Correa (33) and Jose Altuve (30)...his 56 career postseason hits are second most in Astros history, trailing only Altuve (60).
- JOSE ALTUVE** drew a bases-loaded walk in the top of the ninth inning, his eighth career postseason go-ahead RBI, second most in Houston playoff history, behind Carlos Correa (9).
- CARLOS CORREA** reached base safely thrice on the afternoon, singling in the top of the ninth and walking twice; marked his 11th career postseason game reaching base thrice, second most in Astros history behind George Springer (12).
- MICHAEL BRANTLEY** doubled in the first inning and finished the game 2-for-5, including a two-run single in the top of the ninth...marked just his second career postseason extra-base hit in 26 career playoff games, alongside an eighth-inning solo homer in Game 5 of the 2019 ALDS at Tampa Bay...also recorded his eighth career postseason multi-hit game, and is batting .412 (7-for-17) in his last for postseason road games.
- KYLE TUCKER** singled in the fourth for his third career postseason hit and first on the road...entered today's game 0-for-2 in three postseason road games.
